



Transporting your cat

Please do not carry your cat in your arms to the cattery. Until he is inside our premises, the responsibility for his safety is entirely yours. Please ensure you have a sturdy carrier of a sufficient size, solid enough to prevent the cat from escaping and yet providing air and a good view. Please use newspaper in the bottom of the carrying box (or a puppy pad) but do not use the bedding intended for his stay. It would be sensible not to feed him before travelling.

Elderly or ailing cats

If your cat is elderly or suffering from a terminal illness, please discuss your wishes with us in the unhappy event of his deterioration or even dying whilst you are away.
